April 10, 2025



U.S. Harmonized Tariff Schedule (USHTS) Summary:

- Regular duty rates applied based on [2025 HTS Revision 8](#)
- Additional tariffs:
 - SEC 301 China tariffs: 25% or 7.5% (applicable only to items made in China; effective 9/24/2018)
9903.88.01/9903.88.02/9903.88.03/9903.88.04 = 25%. 9903.88.15 = 7.5% [U.S. 301 Lists \(all lists combined\)](#)
 - NEA/IEEPA China: 20% (applicable to items made in China and Hong Kong; effective 3/4/2025)
 - NEA/IEEPA Canada: 25% (applicable to items made in Canada that are not USMCA-compliant; effective 3/6/2025)
 - NEA/IEEPA Mexico: 25% (applicable to items made in Mexico that are not USMCA-compliant; effective 3/6/2025)
 - SEC 232 steel and steel derivatives: 25% (applicable to items from all countries if contains steel and steel derivatives; effective 3/12/2025)
 - SEC 232 aluminum and aluminum derivatives: 25% (applicable to items from all countries if contains aluminum and aluminum derivatives; effective 3/12/2025)
 - Reciprocal baseline: 10% (applicable to all countries; effective 4/5/2025)
 - Reciprocal [Annex List](#) (Annex List tariff rate will override the reciprocal baseline tariff of 10%; effective 4/9/2025)
– *Note: Reciprocal tariffs paused for 90 days for all countries, except China.*
 - Automotive tariff: 25% (cars, trucks, and some automotive parts; applicable to all countries; effective 4/3/2025)

All Applicable Tariffs are Stacked:

- For Air Import
 - Duty rate + additional applicable tariffs + Merchandise Processing Fee (MPF) (0.3464% of the FOB value)
- For Ocean Import
 - Duty rate + additional applicable tariffs + MPF + Harbor Maintenance Fee (HMF) (0.125% of the FOB value)

Exemptions and Additional Notes:

- De minimis rule will no longer apply to China and Hong Kong products; effective 5/2/2025.
- Canada and Mexico are exempt from the new April tariffs, due to existing specific trade actions.
- Potash imports from Canada and Mexico that are USMCA-compliant are exempt from the additional tariffs.
